



Examples of Selection Criteria for the EAMA

- Category 1** MD members of the staff with a PhD degree and experience in clinical work, research and education of students of departments for geriatric medicine of university hospitals.
- Category 2** MD members of the staff with a PhD degree and experience in clinical work and participating in the training of geriatricians in department for geriatric medicine of general hospitals with specialist training facilities.
- Category 3** MD members of the staff preparing a PhD degree and experience in clinical work, research and education of students of departments for geriatric medicine of university hospitals.
- Category 4** MD members of the staff* without a PhD degree, but with experience in clinical work and participating in the training of geriatricians in departments for geriatric medicine of general hospitals with specialist training facilities.
- Category 5** MD members of the staff with a PhD degree and with experience in clinical work in departments for geriatric medicine of general hospitals without specialist training facilities.

* Category 5 has been included for political reasons; to describe persons which only a small chance to be selected at the national level and to be proposed for the international selection procedure.
